

How does Limit Per User work?

PaymentsPlus places the limit on EACH Listing, Then limits the total that can be purchased at that price.

Maximum Listings Per User

Every listing Product can have a different setting for the maximum listings a user can place. (note this is a global setting not an individual user setting).

Example:

Product 1, 3months Standard Listing \$25.00 Max Listings 5
Product 2, 6 months Standard Listing \$40.00 Max Listings 3
Product 3, 2 Years Featured Listing \$100.00 Max Listings Unlimited
Product 4, 1 Years Free Basic Text Listing, Max Listings 1

Explaining further....

Taking Product 1 above this means

A user can purchase ONE Standard Listing each time for 3 Months publication at a cost of \$25.00 EACH. The maximum they can purchase at this price is 5. The listings are counted from Current and Pending listings using the same product. If the limit has not been exceeded then they can place another listing at that price.
